Context

It is January 2025. Russia has managed to successfully occupy and take control of the whole Ukrainian territory. Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania have been attacked and successfully put under full occupation one week ago. 3 days ago Poland was also attacked by Russian and North Korean troops, from the side of Belarusian, Russian and Lithuanian borders. No NATO or EU support mechanisms have been implemented so far to help the attacked member-states. The scheduled ahead European Parliament session in Strasbourg is going as planned, with the topic of the War as main on the agenda. I will be impersonating a Polish MEP Dominik Tarczyński, from Law and Justice, a right-wing party in Poland, representing the European Conservatives and Reformists Group in the EP. He has recently gained a lot of popularity on social media, due to his straightforward language, especially in the context of migration issues, but also his critique of the EU for their reaction to the war in Ukraine.

Speech

Dear Members of the European Parliament, Madam President, the Citizens of Western Europe, the People of States under the attack of the Russian aggressor,

You all speak so nicely of European values, European solidarity and European support, so I want to ask are you serious? The children are dying, and we need to talk about the facts. The facts are: Poland and our Baltic brothers have been attacked by Russia. How many of you send your troops in support? 0 of you, none. All this talk about the European community, means completely nothing for the Polish people right now fighting with the Russian forces for their own lives, their own lands, their own history and YOUR security.

Since then, we have been rebuilding our relationship, for you to leave us once again in one of the most difficult times in the history of Poland.

You may want to say, we could not predict this would happen, we are shocked, but you have no right to be surprised. We, the Eastern Bloc warned you about this for over 30 years. But you, the self-centred Western elites never listened to us. You, crazy leftists focused on the gender madness and protecting the Muslim terrorist who destroy our civilizational progress, while at the same time doing funny business with Putin. What happened to Poland is your fault. Why? Because not only are you not helping us right now, but also you allowed Putin to rise in power.

You, Germans from EPP and your little gas pipeline. And you, Belgians protecting your diamond businesses, delaying the sanction packages. And, the technocratic Commission celebrating the Netflix ban in Russia.

History repeated itself, and you are once again on the wrong side of history. You have blood of Polish people on your hands and we will never forgive you for this. The European Union, the European Community and Europe will never return to exist in the same form. They will cease to exist soon. The trust is lost and we the Eastern Bloc learned our lessons. Never count on your Western allies. They will turn their backs on you.

I send my prayers to my Baltic brothers and Polish people at the frontlines. As of now, I am officially denouncing my MEP mandate and I do not wish to be associated with this organization of traitors and cowards.
